We provide essential shipping services, including logistics, technical, operations and commercial chartering support to WFS.



Setting High Safety Standards



Annual Marine Safety Visits

Each year, WFS aims for a marine safety expert to spend 1.5 days on each vessel, reviewing over 500 health and safety items, and engaging with officers and crew at all levels. The inspection covers vessel maintenance, safety reporting, and mental health awareness for seafarers.

Office Visits

WFS visits time-charter ship owners and technical managers every two years to align safety information and expectations, and to strengthen relations with its ship operators.

Safety Training

WFS provides biannual safety training for vessel crews, focusing on methanol handling and nitrogen awareness. Nitrogen is used to prevent fires and explosions in cargo tanks but can cause asphyxiation.
